


## Scotts Steering Stabilizer Hand Guard Mount











USE Loctite or Thread Locking Agent on M4 x 10 Bolts

- 1) Install the Handguard Barclamp with the 4 bolts tightened evenly
- 2) Find your model on the application page (for example: 2017 450 RR)
- 3) Decide which position you want to run your bars in (example: position 4 is 41)
- 4) Find the tabs that match that position (they would be marked 41 in this case)
- 5) Install the tabs as per the pictures, readable from the riders view, using Loc-tite
- 6) Note the "correct alignment" pictures to insure it is correctly aligned
